

Dengie Marshes Wind Farm – Stage Two Consultation

The Dengie Marshes Wind Farm Team has identified an opportunity on the Dengie Peninsula for a new renewable energy project.

We're writing to let you know our stage two consultation will run from 23 June 2025 to 21 July 2025. Your views are important to us, and we want to ensure that the project and community benefit fund reflects what is most important to the local community.

We've listened to the feedback received during our first consultation and used it to shape the layout and design and the means of access for construction. This is alongside

ongoing environmental, technical and engineering assessments. **Since Stage One, we have reduced the number of turbines from 17 to 15, and lowered the maximum height from 220 to 200 metres.**

Our consultation materials, including the turbine layout, will be available online from 23 June, and in-person at our consultation events.

The feedback we've received so far from the community has helped shape the project in meaningful ways. Importantly, we now propose to reuse the existing marine transfer facility on the River Crouch for the delivery of the turbines and associated equipment. This next stage of consultation is an opportunity for us to continue that conversation and ensure this project brings lasting benefits to the local area.
